

MACKINAC COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

Wednesday, September 19 2018

The Mackinac County Board of Commissioners held a Committee of the Whole meeting on Wednesday, September 19, 2018 in the County Annex Building, Board Room, 100 S. Marley St., St. Ignace, MI.

The meeting was called to order by Chair Patrick at 4:30 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance of the United States of America was recited.

Public Comment – Treasurer Goudreau discussed previous decisions of the board regarding single point of entry.

Security/Single Point of Entry – The board discussed options and cost estimates to provide a single point of entry. Sheriff Strait distributed two proposals for Personnel costs and Studies by Oak City for various options. The options the board reviewed are as follows:

Study 1 - East side entrance with elevator

Study 2 - East side entrance with chair lift thru Clerk's office

Study 3 - West side entrance with chair lift thru Security office

Study 4 - Connect buildings (Sheriff/Courthouse/Annex) with chair lift

After a lengthy discussion the board decided to discuss a temporary single point of entry at their next meeting through either the handicap entrance or the West entrance of the Courthouse and pursue Study 3 and Study 4 for the long term goal.
